

# Yelverton Bowmen - WA 25



Please fill out with blue or black ink only and submit to the records officer on completion of all qualifying rounds undertaken during a club competition, or in support of a Bowman Classification.

The WA25 round consist of 60 arrows shot in ends of 3 arrows on a 60cm full size or Triple Face target at 25 metres. You are allowed a minimum of two ends of sighters (6 arrows) but a maximum of 45 minutes before starting your scoring arrows.

The WA25 round uses 10 zone scoring (**10-1**). Mark misses with an **M**.

If using a Vertical 3 Spot target face, use 5 zone scoring (**10-6**). You must shoot one arrow at each target face. Any arrows shot out of the 6-ring are marked as a miss (**M**).
