Severity	Classification	Action
6 to 9	Unacceptable	Shooting must not commence until the risk has been reduced considerably. If it is not possible to reduce the risk shooting may have to remain prohibited.
3 to 5	Moderate Risk	Efforts should be made to reduce the risk. When moderate risk is associated with "Extremely harmful" consequences, extra control measures must be put in place to reduce the risk.
1 to 2	Trivial to Tolerable Risk	No action required but monitor and review
