

Yelverton Bowmen Outdoor Nationals Club Tournament Sunday 15th September 2024

Rounds

Ladies, Gentlemen's and Juniors (ages Under 18) - Archery GB National Rounds

All archers will shoot on 122cm faces with rounds entered in accordance with current (at time of entry) 252 classification i.e. existing 252 qualification @ 40 yards = entry to National 50.

National rounds are 4 dozen arrows at the longer distance followed by 2 dozen arrows at the shorter distance (72 arrows total)

Rounds available: New National (100/80 yards)

Long National (80/60 yards) National (60/50 yards) National 50 (50/40 yards) National 40 (40/30 yards) National 30 (30/20 yards)

There will be a maximum of 4 archers per target shooting in 2 details. 6 arrows to be shot in two minutes, controlled by timers.

Note: scores shot in 1st session for first 3 dozen arrows may also be used towards club 252 qualifiers.

Shooting to be carried out in accordance with WA Rules – to be explained at assembly.

Equipment Inspection will take place prior to practice.

Awards Awards for Ladies, Gentlemen and Juniors for Recurve/Compound/Longbow/Barebow (according to entries)

Medals awarded in bow styles as follows - 1^{st} – 1 Archer, 2^{nd} – 3 Archers, 3^{rd} – 5 or more archers.

Trophies awarded to 1st place (highest scoring) archer in each category

Special Requirements: Please indicate on entry form if you are visually impaired, shoot from a wheelchair or have other specific requirements and discuss with Tournament Organiser.

Declaration: When signing the entry form you are declaring that you will comply with the Archery GB rules on dress, and that you are a paid-up member of Archery GB or World Archery (Please ensure you bring your membership card as it will be checked at registration)

Note: When you enter the competition, the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists, and results may be published showing first names, surname, gender, bow style, date of birth/age category, Club (and ID), Round, Disabled (Y/N), Disability Info. By signing the entry form you are agreeing to this.

Drug Testing: Club Record status shoots will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must

comply. A refusal will be treated as a positive result.

Dress: Archers must comply with Archery GB rule 307 (sort of!)

Liability: The Devon and Cornwall Archery Society, YMCA Plymouth, Yelverton Bowmen and their members cannot

accept responsibility for vehicles or property left on the grounds.
