## Yelverton Bowmen - Worcester

Please fill out with blue or black ink only and submit to the records officer on completion of all qualifying rounds undertaken during a club competition, or in support of a Bowman Classification.



The Worcester round consist of 60 arrows shot in ends of 5 arrows on a 16in full size, five zone or five centre with additional "X-Ring" target at 20 yards. One end of sighters (5 arrows) shall be shot before scoring.

Compound archers shall use a 5-spot target face with 2 zone scoring.

Note that in a Worcester round two faces are placed vertically on the boss, with each archer shooting initially at either the top or bottom, and then switching every 6 ends (2.5 dozen arrows). A maximum of four target faces per boss is allowed.

Scoring will be as follows:

- Full Size Target 5, 4, 3, 2, 1, reading from the centre white circle.
- Five Centre Target (compound) 5 and 4, reading from the centre white circle.
- Five Centre Target "X-Ring" X-Ring will score as an X, and count as 5.
- Mark misses with an **M**.
